This facility is a central command and processing area for Fire and Public Safety. This facility was built in preparation for the increased security demands of the growing metropolitan Salt Lake Area. It was completed shortly before the 2002 Winter Olympics and was used extensively by Federal Agencies during that time.

**THE SYSTEM'S BASIC FUNCTIONS INCLUDED THE FOLLOWING:**

- Crestron E-Control
- Video runs over Cat 5 cable
- Receive Video feeds from the DOT TOC, other state agencies, DVD, and network connections
- Observation room with separate audio system
- Display video inputs via a 2 by 2 video wall
- Rear Projector large screen
- Polycom audio and video conference
