THE SYSTEM'S BASIC FUNCTIONS INCLUDED THE FOLLOWING:

- Allowing all associated participants to clearly and effortlessly hear all proceedings and presented material. Including those that are hard of hearing or speak a foreign language.
- Video displays for the attorneys, jury, judge and gallery to in-sure all participants view the same evidence or presented video information simultaneously.
- Video conferencing and teleconferencing systems for video arraignment and interpretation.
- Control of the system is accomplished via a touch panel at the Judges and clerks desks respectively. Once the mode of operation has been selected, the system typically operates with-out the need for user intervention.
- Digital archiving of the audio as well local camera feeds.
